- 5. The Settler/Founder/Chairman shall continue to hold office until he resigns or he is not interested to continue as Settler/Founder/Chairman. The Board has no power to appoint a new person as Settler/Founder/Chairman. It is only for the Settler/Founder/Chairman to continue or to discontinue as Settler/Founder/Chairman of the Trust.
- 6. The initial contribution of Rs.5,000/- (Five thousand Rupees only) made by the Settler/Founder/Chairman of the Trust shall hereby vest in the name of the Trust and shall continue to be the initial trust fund.
- 7. The Trust funds may be augmented by the income from the initial fund and also by donations and other contributions from time to time.
- 8. The funds of the Trust shall not be applied for any purpose other than the objects of the Trust.

2. OBJECTIVES OF THE TRUST:

- 1) To provide education and financial facilities to the poor pupils who obtained good marks in 7th class, 10th Class, Inter, Degree and Engineering and Medicine students who obtained ranks. To provide financial assistance for the needy in appearing for Civil Services and other competitive examinations. For providing and arranging Food, Clothes, shelter, education, medical aid and other reliefs and supports to the needy, less privileged, Orphans, oppressed persons, children and women, aged or sick of all communities and beliefs.
- 2) To encourage social, traditional activities irrespective of caste, creed and community to uplift the citizens.
- 3) To arrange for donating, providing and/or distributing daily use articles and necessities such as Food, Clothing, medicines, medical aid to the victims of natural calamities such as to the Street children and sufferers during floods, epidemics, earth quakes, famine, fire etc. conditions.
- 4) To promote Education and to establish Schools/Colleges/Institutions in different parts of the country on the lines of emulation -worthy unique models set up by worthy institutions aiming at bringing about radical change in the concept and quality of education for the good of the public through experienced Teachers, Professors etc.,
- 5) To set up Children's Homes, Student Homes, Hostels, Training Centers, Centers for the blind, deaf and dumb, invalids' Home, asylums for the

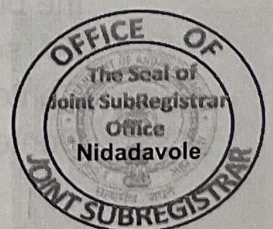

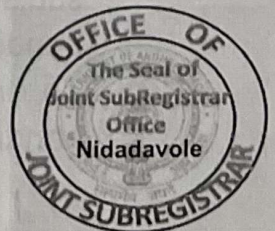



- 15) To promote interest in/development of Agriculture, Orchid Plantations, Flowers / Oil- seeds Plants medicinal plants growth, animal husbandry, Poultry farming, research for high-yield superior grade seeds development, dairy farms, development for augmenting the efforts of the small farmers and rural development.



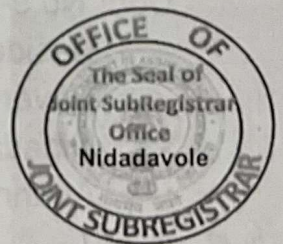

- a) The Trustees co-opted shall hold office only for three years and are liable for retirement. The Trustees, whose terms of office expire after the period of three years, are eligible to be co-opted as Trustees again by the existing Trustees. The Trustee may if he/she so desires, resign his/her trusteeship even before the expiry of the terms of this Trusteeship.
- b) The Trustees shall appoint one among them as Managing Trustee of the Board of Trustee.
- c) **Mr.Mr. SARIPALLI RAVI KUMAR** is the Founder of the Trust shall be Managing Trustee for life. The Managing Trustee shall act as Chairman and preside at all the meetings of the Trust.

4. Meeting of the Board of Trustees.

In the absence of the Chairman / Managing Trustee at any Meeting, the Vice Chairman will act as the Chairman of the Meeting and after final decision with the consent of the Managing Trustee, whose decision is the final one.

5. Powers and Duties of the Board of Trustees:

- a) The trust may receive donations of money and/or properties which were received shall be at the absolute disposal of the trust.
- b) The Trustees shall invest the properties and money for the Trust in such manner as prescribed under Sec. 11 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and other statutory laws.

- c) The Board of Trustees shall meet as often as necessary and their proceedings shall be recorded regularly in the Minutes book to be maintained for the purpose. In any resolution to be passed touching the administration of the Trust, the opinion of the majority shall prevail. It shall be competent however for the trustees to decide matters by circulation. In case there being equality of votes, the Chairman of the Meeting has casting vote for the purpose of deciding the issue.
- d) After the demise of the present Founder/Chairman the Board of Trustees have right to appoint another by conducting a meeting with 2/3rd majority of the meeting. In which the Vice Chairman's decision is final.
- e) Any of the Trust or to undertake any activities in furtherance of the main objects of the Trust, should be done with the prior permission of the Commissioner of Income Tax.
- f) Proper books of account shall be maintained of the Trust and shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant every year.
- g) To do such other lawful things as are incidental in carrying out the administration and management of the Trust.
- h) The Trustees shall maintain the minutes book in which the proceedings of all meetings of the Trustees shall be recorded by the Trustees and the same shall be signed by Founder/Chairman of the meeting.
- i) The Trustees may frame rules and regulations as to the duties and responsibilities of each Trustees, to appoint sub-committees, mode of conducting any other matters connected with the administration of the Trust and its management.
- j) The Vice Chairman of the Trust having responsible to conduct Meetings, calling higher officials to attend the meetings, General Body meeting, Executive Committee Meetings or any nature for which the Vice Chairman having responsibility to report the same to other executive members of the Trust.

6. **Custody of Documents:**
